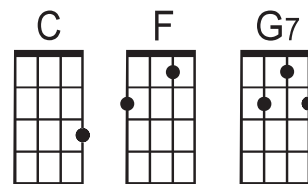

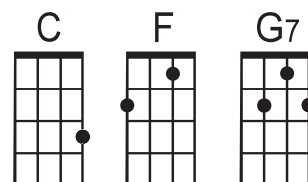

It was a (G7) ditty, he learned in the (F) city

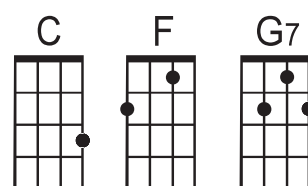
Comma te (C) yi yi yeah Comma te yippity yi yeah
