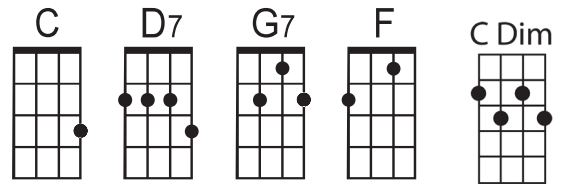

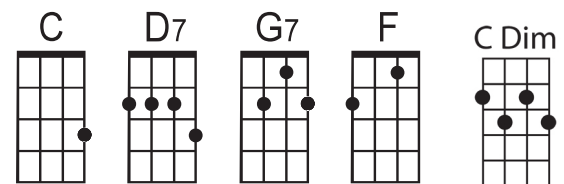
(C) Standing by the (G7) fruit store on the (C) corner
