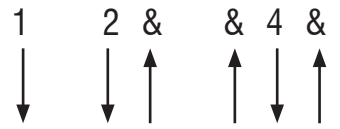
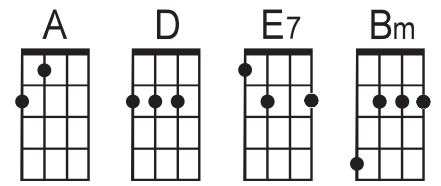

INTRO:(A) (D) (E7) (A) X 2

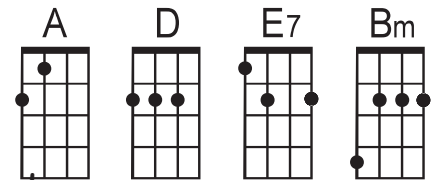


VERSE 1:

I had to (E7) leave a little girl in (A) Kingston town

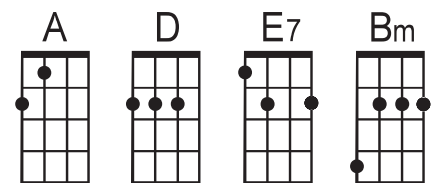


VERSE 2:
